# PATTERN OF PETITIONS RECEIVED IN OPEN HOUSE

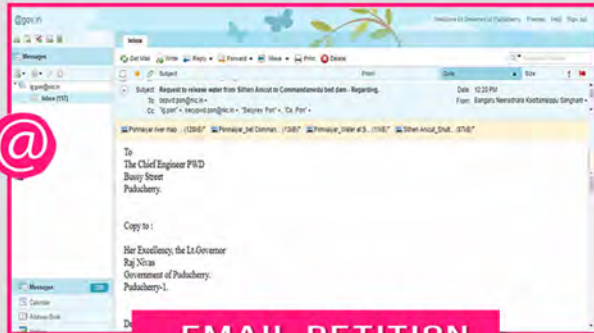
