# Dr. Tamilisai Soundararajan - Lt. Governor, Puducherry

### **COVID -19 INITIATIVES**

- On the very first day of assumption of office of Lt. Governor visited the dedicated COVID hospital for Vaccination Drive Initiatives and Interacted with frontline health workers.
- Constituted Covid Vaccination Task Force Committee involving JIPMER, ICMR, all medical colleges, IMA, NGOs for effective vaccination rollout.
- The Committee has held Five meetings every week on Thursday to review and Strategize vaccination drive
- Launched Vaccination awareness Programme on 21.03.2021 to encourage people to take COVID19 vaccination.
- Flagged off Mobile Campaign Van to promote Mask up Puducherry | Mask my India and vaccination Awareness
- Sanction accorded for purchase of 600 nos. hospital cots for COVID management

### **WELFARE INITIATIVES**

- District Review Meeting at Karaikal, to review welfare schemes and on-going Projects, civic Amenities, delivery of public services on 20.2.2021.
- Review of the resumed Mid Day Meal scheme and Morning Supplementary Milk distribution programme in Rural and Urban Government Schools.
- Approval accorded for distribution of eggs under Supplementary Nutrition Programme(SNP) in Anganwadi

#### **REVIEW MEETINGS HELD**

- A total of 24 (Twenty Four) review Meetings were held from the date of assumption
- Daily Review Meeting is held at 10.30 AM with the Advisors to Lt. Governor
- Review Meetings with Key Officers in regard to Covid Management, Green Puducherry, resolution of specific public grievance and matters of administration were held

### **GRIEVANCE REDRESS**

- Announcement of ex-gratia to the kin of Asina Begum washed away in to floods.
- Relief measures initiated / reviewed at the flood affected areas of Rainbow Nagar, SonamPalayam, Murungapakkam, Thengathitu on 21<sup>st</sup> Feb 2021.
- Preventive measure to overcome bus transportation strike in neighbouring State.
- Visit to Kalapet to attend to civic complaints viz., Sewerage overflow
- Travelled as co-passenger in Mofussil Bus service from Puducherry to Bahour to resolve grievance of travelling public and assess monsoon damaged road conditions.
- Learning of drying up of trees on Promenade Beach, watered the trees to set an example for emulation.
- Visited Government Quarters located at Lawspet, Puducherry based on the grievances.
- Surprise Inspection of Interstate border Check post late in the night at 1.15 AM during return from Telengana to ensure vigilant surveillance mechanisms amidst pandemics and State Elections 2021.

#### **PEOPLE CENTRIC MEASURES**

- On the advice tendered to reduce VAT on Petrol / Diesel the proposal submitted for reduction of VAT by 2 %, reducing the cost approximately by Rs.1.80/- was approved.
- Sanction accorded for Rs 8.00 crore for awarding the work of "Disposal of Legacy Waste" from the Kurumbapet dumpsite through Bio-remediation and Bio-mining"
- Sanction accorded for repair of Arterial Roads to the tune of Rs 80.00 Crores
- Sanction accorded for various Tourism Infrastructures project and Smart City Projects.

## **RESOLUTION OF LEGACY ISSUES**

- Persuaded the PSHM Association, AIDS Control employees Association to call off their ongoing strike.
- Discussion held with Bus operator representatives to restore free bus services to students.
- Sanction accorded for release of Salary and pensions to Teaching and non teaching staff of Govt. aided Private schools that had been withheld on administrative grounds.
- Sanction was accorded for release of free ration for the left out period of 6 months to BPL card holders and for 4 months to APL card holders and 4 months
- Delegated with Financial powers, all proposals that required expenditure sanction / approval of L.G, were cleared till late night on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2021 ensuring booking of expenditure about 92% of Budget.
- Review Meetings held to revive closed down Public Distribution Fair Price Shops
- Review Meetings held to explore feasibility of revival of closed down Textile Mills / Sugar Factory etc.,
