The students of 10th & 11th Std in Puducherry and Karaikal will be declared pass as per the guidelines of Kerala and Andhra Pradesh Boards respectively.
- -Approval was accorded for sanction of Rs.29.65 Cr for payment of Old Age/Widow/destitute pension to 1,54,847 beneficiaries.
- •Expost facto expenditure sanction of Rs.24.35 Lakh for purchase of diet and non-diet items to Anganwadi Centres of Mahe and Yanam regions.
- •Approved modification of funds proposed by Adi Dravidar Welfare and Scheduled Tribe Welfare Department for meeting the expenditure of Rs.6.22 crore towards the continuing scheme of free dhotis and sarees to SC people every year on account of festivity to be paid in the form of DBT.


