N O T I F I C A T I O N

WHEREAS the Private Secretary to the Lieutenant-Governor, Pondicherry being the person, who proposes to apply the balances remaining in the Lieutenant-Governor's Cyclone Relief Fund and Lieutenant-Governor's Welfare Fund, Pondicherry in trust for charitable purposes, has applied for vesting the funds mentioned in Schedule A annexed hereto in the Treasurer of Charitable Endowments for Pondicherry and for the settlement of a Scheme for the administration of the said funds

It is hereby notified that the Lieutenant-Governor, Pondicherry, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 4 and 5 of the Charitable Endowments Act, 1890 (Central Act VI of 1890) and upon the application as aforesaid doth hereby order that the monies set out in Schedule A annexed hereto shall, as from the date of publication of this Notification, be vested in the Treasurer of Charitable Endowments for Pondicherry, to be held by him and his successors in office (subject to the provisions of the said Act and the rules made thereunder), and to hold the said monies and income thereof and accrual thereof in accordance with the trust and terms set out in the Scheme set forth in Schedule B annexed hereto for the administration of the said funds;

And it is hereby notified that the scheme set forth in Schedule B annexed hereto has, under sub-section (1) of section 5 of the said Act, been settled for the administration of the said funds and under sub-section (3) of the said section 5 of the said Act, it is hereby further ordered that it shall come into force with immediate effect.

S C H E D U L E A

Rupees 4,42,138-07 (Four lakhs forty two thousand one hundred and thirty eight and paise eighty seven only) in the credit of Lieutenant-Governor's Cyclone Relief Fund and Rs. 18,070-49 (Rupees eighteen thousand and seventy and paise forty nine only) in the credit of Lieutenant-Governor's Welfare Fund.

S C H E D U L E B

The scheme for the administration of the fund

1. The fund shall be known as the Lieutenant-Governor's Welfare Fund.
2. The objects of the fund shall be:-
  - (i) to grant relief in cases of privation and also to those affected by fire, flood, cyclone, sea erosion and similar other natural calamities;



property and to return them to their normal condition;

(iii) to grant financial assistance, both recurring and non-recurring to the workers thrown out of employment for reasons beyond their control in units not covered by the Employees State Insurance Scheme and Employees Provident Fund Scheme in the traditional sector alone, provided that the family income of the worker does not exceed Rs. 150/- p.m. and, the amount of relief granted does not exceed two weeks' wages in case of non-recurring grants or three months' wages in case of recurring grants;

(iv) to administer and apply the funds for other welfare measures as the General Committee as hereinafter constituted may, by making byelaws, provide for; and

(v) to do all other things which are incidental to the above objects.

3. The objectives of the fund shall extend to the whole of the Union Territory of Pondicherry.

4. The fund will be constituted with the initial contribution of Rs. 4,60,209-36 (Rupees four lakhs sixty thousand two hundred and nine and paise thirty six only) mentioned in Schedule A and standing as balance in the Lieutenant-Governor's Cyclone Relief Fund and Lieutenant-Governor's Welfare Fund and further contributions and donations received from the Central/State Governments and voluntary organisations and the public and shall also include the income from the assets of the fund.

5. For the management and administration of the Fund a General Committee shall be constituted consisting of the following members, namely:-

6. Not less than three members shall form a quorum. The quorum shall be determined by a majority of votes of the members present and voting on the question. In case of equality of votes the Chairman or the member present shall have a casting vote.

7. The General Committee may function notwithstanding any vacancy in its constitution. In the absence of the Chairman or when there is a vacancy in the office of the Chairman the senior most member attending shall preside over the Committee.




